Construction Work to Begin at Wakefield Park

Some construction impacts to pedestrian and bicycle trails

Construction of the Capital Beltway HOT Lanes on I-495 in Fairfax County will entail work at and near some of the County's parks, including Wakefield Park. Although most of the work will have no impact on park trails, some construction activity will affect some pedestrian and bicycle trails.

Wakefield Park Impacts

1) Late October 2009 - A small section of the mountain bike trail will be closed to install a sanitary sewer pipe with two new structures located north of the Audrey Moore RECenter. This work will last approximately **two months**, and the existing trail will be rerouted around the excavation area.

2) Early November 2009 - South of the existing access road of the park, clearing and grubbing will be needed to install a new retaining wall and erosion controls at a box culvert outfall. This work will begin early November, with construction activity at this location lasting about **6 months**. A section of the mountain bike trail just south of the Little River Turnpike Interchange will have to be closed to perform this work.
