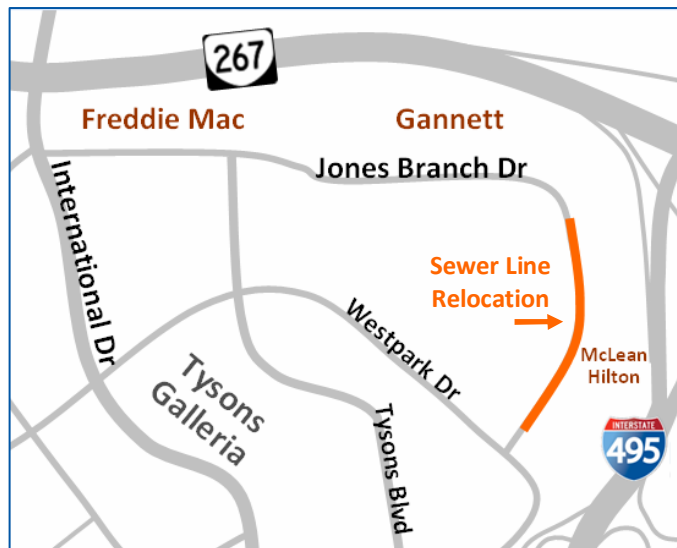
## Jones Branch Drive: Sewer Line Relocation

*Two Lanes to be closed on Jones Branch Drive for 8-10 weeks starting Week of July 14*

In preparation for construction of the future HOT Lanes connection to Jones Branch Drive, work to relocate a sewer line on Jones Branch Drive will begin the week of July 14. The two lanes on the east side on Jones Branch Drive will be closed from just after the Westpark Drive/Jones Branch Drive intersection to the southern entrance to the Gannett building. Traffic will be shifted to the west side with one lane in each direction. The traffic shift will allow construction workers on the Capital Beltway High Occupancy Toll (HOT) Lanes Project to replace an 850 foot section of 12-inch diameter sewer pipe containing asbestos.

### Removal operation of old sewer pipes

Operators in anti-contamination clothing and respirators will carefully wrap, cut and seal 20-foot sections of pipe which will then be carefully removed from beneath the existing roadway. Asbestos pipe removal operations will be performed only during daylight hours and under dry conditions. An industrial hygienist will be on-site monitoring the operations as well as continuous air sampling equipment. The "wrap and cut" asbestos abatement operation is self-contained and the likelihood of asbestos in the pipe becoming friable and airborne is extremely remote. Once the old piping is removed construction personnel will install new, asbestos free sewer line.



### Businesses will remain accessible on Jones Branch Drive

During the traffic shift associated with this operation, employees and visitors will have access to office buildings along this corridor. In some cases, traffic may be rerouted in order to enter an office complex. Drivers should slow down and follow posted signs in the area. The work will be divided into two phases as workers move along the length of the pipe.

### Future HOT Lanes connection

The sewer line is being replaced as part of work associated with building a direct connection from the HOT Lanes to Jones Branch Drive. When complete, this new access point will allow carpoolers, buses, and toll paying customers to travel on and off the Capital Beltway from Jones Branch Drive. Construction of this new connection will begin early 2011.
