LEESBURG PIKE TO I-495 SOUTH WEEKEND LANE CLOSURE SCHEDULED

Motorists should expect delays

ALEXANDRIA— On Friday, Sept. 9 and Saturday, Sept. 10 from 9:30 a.m. until 2 p.m. and again on Sunday, Sept. 11 from 9:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., the right ramp lane from Leesburg Pike (Route 7) east and west onto I-495 south will be closed for sound wall work. The ramp lane closure will extend onto I-495 south just past the Route 7 merge.

Route 7 motorists heading onto I-495 south will maintain Beltway access during the lane closure but should use caution when merging.

Motorists on I-495 south and Leesburg Pike may encounter periodic delays during peak hours approaching the interchange. This work is part of the Capital Beltway High Occupancy Toll (HOT) Lanes Project.

Sound wall work is weather permitting.

About the HOT Lanes Project: Bridge and road work is underway along all the Capital Beltway's interchanges inside the HOT Lanes Project work zone between the Springfield Interchange and just north of the Dulles Toll Road. These new bridges and interchange connections are part of the \$260 million infrastructure replacement in support of the \$1.4 billion Capital Beltway HOT Lanes project.
