## Lewinsville Road Bridge: **UPDATE**

*Night demolition of old bridge on schedule*

Work continues on the 495 Express Lanes and the nighttime demolition of the old Lewinsville Road Bridge. The most disruptive part of the bridge demolition, the removal of the deck concrete from the structural steel is now complete. Crews can now move forward with the next stages of demolition. The removal of the steel across the Beltway and demolishing the piers and abutments could be complete as early as January 28, depending on the weather.

### Details

- Demolition of the old bridge started on Jan. 3 and will take 3-4 weeks to complete
- All demolition work will take place at night, 7 days a week, 11 p.m. to 4 a.m., with the exception of Saturdays in which hours will be extended through 7 a.m.
- During demolition, the first 8-12 nights of work produced especially loud noise while removing the concrete deck. Future demolition stages are less disruptive.

### Why is this work performed at night?

Night demolition ensures the safety of all motorists and our workforce and minimizes the impact on traffic. Overnight hours ensure that work is performed when traffic volumes are the lightest. Demolition personnel are doing their best to minimize the time needed to complete the work.

### Note to travelers

Single, multiple and temporary total lane closures on northbound and southbound I-495 at the Lewinsville Road overpass will be put in place during demolition.
